


Regional variation still evident in England

Post-mortem examination continues to vary between stillbirths and neonatal deaths Almost all parents of

stillborn babies were offfered a post-mortem

Of these parents, 1 in 2

consented to a post-mortem

8 out of 10 parents of babies who died neonatally were offered a post-mortem

Of these parents, 1 in 3 consented

carried out for: 9 out of 10 stillbirths but for only

Placental histology was

7 out of 10 neonatal deaths which occurred on day 1, or were related to problems during delivery
