

Results

Parents and doctors agreed that this question is important and that a trial should be done

A trial comparing closure at six weeks after stoma formation to twelve weeks after stoma formation would **probably not be practical** to do



What might work: a trial looking at babies with a stoma formed as part of emergency care, **comparing**:



Closure at six weeks after stoma formation

With The clinician waiting to close the stoma later

Where In all cases, the stoma is closed after the baby has passed 32 weeks gestational age

And looking at Which group of babies gains the most weight, or which group stays longest in hospital
